

## Travel Directions to the Tallong Campus

For those drivers using **GPS** be certain that you select Old Wingello Road TALLONG and not Bundanoon (which is 25km away). Download the route prior to departure as you will lose internet connection close to the campus in the “black spots”.

### Travelling South from Sydney

**OPTION 1 For Vehicles over 3.2 Metres in Height** Continue past Sutton Forest Shell/McDonald’s then turn LEFT off the Highway just after Paddy’s Creek and take the Murrimba Road to Wingello. Before you cross the railway line at Wingello turn right, you will see a sign post indicating “**Santa Sabina College**”. Travel southward for about **7 kms (on gravel)** and be aware that the road in places is narrow. You will cross over a concrete floodway at a creek and after passing two other properties (the last called “Wyadra”) you will see the Tallong Campus on the right. Turn right at the gate and follow the drive to the top of the hill where the Car Park is signposted.

**OPTION 2** Turn LEFT off the Hume Highway at the Tallong/Bundanoon turn-off which is about 21 kilometres past the Shell Service Station at Sutton Forest (just before the Marulan truck inspection station). Travel about 7 kms to Tallong. After passing the General Store on the right and the Railway Station on your left, the sealed road veers to the right, but you take the gravel road that goes off to the left where there is a signpost for Santa Sabina College. Follow this gravel road under the railway line (**CLEARANCE IS 3.2 METRES**) and after about **2 kms (on gravel)** you will see the entrance gates to the Tallong Campus on the left. Turn left at the gate and follow the drive to the top of the hill where you are sign posted to the carpark.

### North from Canberra

**OPTION 3** Turn RIGHT off the Hume Highway at the Tallong/Bundanoon turn off which is about 500 metres past the Heavy Vehicle Checking Stations on each side of the Highway at Marulan. Travel 7 kilometres to Tallong, after passing the General Store on the right and the Railway Station on your left, the sealed road veers to the right, but you take the gravel road that goes off to the left where there is a signpost for “Santa Sabina College”. Follow this gravel road under the railway line (**CLEARANCE IS 3.2 METRES**) and after 2 kms you will see the entrance gates to the Tallong Campus on the left. Turn left at the gate and follow the drive to the top of the hill where the carpark is sign posted.
